- Separate page
- Title “Works Cited” centered at the top of the page
- Citations in alphabetical order
- Citations use correct format and contain all necessary information (see below)
- Single-space the citations
- Double-spaced between citations

Books

Author’s last name, Author’s first name. Title of the Book. City published, State published: Publisher Company Name, Copyright year.

Example Citation:

Rowling, J. K. Harry Potter and the Chamber of Secrets. New York, NY: Scholastic, Inc., 1999.

Encyclopedias

Author’s last name, Authors first name (if there is one). “Title of the Article.” Title of the Encyclopedia. Copyright year.

Example Citations:

“Chemistry.” Encyclopedia Britannica. 2005.

Ogden, Shepherd. “Gardening.” World Book Student. 2009.

Websites

Author’s last name, Authors first name (if there is one). Title of the Website.

NO WIKIPEDIA ARTICLES!!!! Wikipedia is not a reliable resource, but you MAY use websites you find through Wikipedia links.

"Title of the Article." Title of the Magazine. Issue month and year.
